

Constitution for a small unincorporated association

1. Name

The name of the group shall be The Leicester Community Voice (LCV)

2. Aims

The aims of LCV Leicester will be:

- To promote and encourage the various communities of Leicester to value their democratic vote and engage with the democratic process by;
 - 1. Ensuring all people eligible are registered to vote in good time before any general or local council elections.
 - 2. Providing access to information on candidates and their voting records.
 - 3. Arranging access to meet and discuss pertinent issues with candidates on an individual or collective basis.
 - 4. Preparing a manifesto of pledges in line with the needs and aspirations of the Leicester and Leicestershire community.
 - 5. Educating the community on the election manifestos of any political parties and independent candidates.
 - 6. Ensure the above reaches all sections of the local communities across all voting age groups.
 - 7. Working in partnership with other organisations to amplify and disseminate relevant information to the local communities.
 - 8. Ensure credibility, integrity and fair due process is always maintained.
 - 9. To engage with community groups who wish to work with us and spread the message of the importance of engaging with the democratic process.
 - 10. To hold elected members of parliament or local councillors to account for their pledges and commitments made during their electoral campaigns.
 - 11. Maintain ongoing direct dialogue with elected members of parliament or local councillors in relation to matters of community interest and LCV concerns.
 - 12. To become a unifying mechanism to reach common ground and achieving goodness within our communities.

3. Membership

Membership is open to anyone who:

- is aged over 16 years old; and
- lives in Leicester and Leicestershire; and
- who supports the aims of LCV in Leicester and Leicestershire

Membership will begin as soon as the membership form and first annual payment has been received.
